"3. Now from the perusal of the records it is seen that the petitioners have sexually assaulted the minor victims and also criminally intimidated them not to disclose the same to the parents"

Having perused the impugned order passed by the High Court, we are of the considered view that the observations made by the High Court in paragraph No.3 are unnecessary and uncalled for as the same may have bearing on the trial and the same are liable to be deleted.
