O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. The appellant apprehends his arrest in connection with FIR bearing No.61/2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
3. The alleged occurrence is of the year 2018 and the FIR itself has been registered only in the year 2024.
4. Though we have been informed that the appellant is involved in other similar cases, the fact remains that he was arrested and granted regular bail in

only one case and in three other cases, he has been granted interim anticipatory bail. Suffice it is to state that the custodial interrogation of the appellant is not required.

5. Considering the above, the impugned order stands set aside and the appellant is granted anticipatory bail, subject to the terms and conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court.
6. We make it clear that the appellant shall cooperate with the investigation.
7. The appeal is allowed, accordingly.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
