O R D E R

Mr. Rameshwar Singh Malik, learned senior counsel, has placed before us order dated 9.12.2019 passed by the Division Bench, in which the following directions have been issued :

"In view of the conjoint prayer made before this Court, the present appeal is disposed of with liberty as aforesaid to the parties to take up proceedings before the learned Single Judge for vacating the interim order granted on 01.01.2019. Till the decision in that regard is taken by the learned Single Judge, the interim order granted by this Court shall remain in operation."

In view of the order now passed, the present petition has virtually become infructuous. However, since the matter is still at the stage of grant of interim relief, we are of the opinion that the High Court should decide the main matter on merits itself on or before 31.1.2020.

We direct the High Court to ensure that the main petition, viz., CWP No.29546/2019 is decided on or before 31.1.2020.

In case the petitioner joins his place of posting in parent department, that will obviously be subject to the final result in the writ petition itself. The petitioner is permitted to approach the Registrar General of the High Court of Punjab & Haryana with a copy of this order, who shall ensure that the writ petition is placed before the roster Bench immediately after the Winter Holidays.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly, along with all pending applications.
