O R D E R

This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Case No.42 of 2016 titled *Rohit Kumar v. Charu Sharma* pending before Principal Judge, Family Court, Nainital (Uttarakhand) to the Family Court, Mathura, U.P.

Despite service of notice, no one has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent-husband. Hence, averments made in the transfer petition remain unrebutted.

In view of the above and considering the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the case at Nainital, we deem it proper to allow the transfer petition and direct transfer of the abovementioned case from Principal Judge, Family Court, Nainital to Family Court, Mathura, U.P. It is accordingly ordered.
