O R D E R

An affidavit has been filed on behalf of the alleged contemnor(s) stating that the entire payment as directed by this Court has been made to the members of the petitioner-Indian Airport Employees' Union (for short 'the Union'). The proof of payment is annexed as 'Annexure-C' to the affidavit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-Union does not dispute the aforesaid fact. However, he has flagged an issue that some of the members of the petitioner-Union in Contempt Petition Nos. 3/2017 and 4-5/2017 have died and thus, payment could not be made to them. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, there are total six such members.

Learned counsel appearing for the contemnor(s) states that in case adequate documentary proof is produced by the legal heirs of the deceased - employees before the concerned authority, the payment due to such deceased employees shall be paid to the legal heirs.

In such circumstances, we hereby provide that the petitioner(s) shall supply all necessary details with regard to the legal heirs of the deceased members to the concerned authority within a period of one week from today and the said authority after being satisfied about the genuineness of the legal heirs shall make the payment within a period of one week thereafter.

The alleged contemnor(s) are further under an obligation to supply the details of the deductions made by them from the payment made to the members of the petitioner-Union within one week.

With the aforesaid directions, the contempt petitions stand closed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
