UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The petitioner has been convicted under Section 304-A IPC and the substantive sentence stands reduced to six months, as a result of the order passed by the High Court.

Initially, the learned Chambers Judge of this Court granted exemption from surrendering whereafter notice was issued in the matter to see if the legal representatives of the deceased victim could be compensated and further relief could be granted to the petitioner.

With the assistance of the learned counsel, we have gone through the record and do not find any reason to interfere with the order passed by the High Court. The substantive relief has already been granted by the High Court. We, therefore, dismiss this Special Leave Petition.

The amount deposited in the Registry pursuant to the order dated 01.03.2021 shall be returned immediately to the petitioner.

Needless to say, the benefit of exemption granted by the learned Chambers Judge now stands terminated. The petitioner shall surrender himself before the concerned Police Station within seven days, failing which he shall be taken in custody immediately.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the concerned Police Station and the jurisdictional Chief Judicial Magistrate for compliance.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
