O R D E R

After some arguments, Mr. Harin P. Raval, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners, seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the High Court by way of filing review petition to establish that the respondent was not continuously employed from 1992 to 2001.

Permission, as sought for, is granted.

Accordingly, the special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

However, it is made clear that if such a review petition is filed by the petitioners, the High Court is requested to consider and dispose it of as expeditiously as possible preferably not later than three months from the date of filing such review petition, in accordance with law.

We also direct that the contempt proceedings shall be stayed till the final decision of review petition.
