O R D E R

Application for impleadment is allowed.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

We may notice that the amount of Rs.50 lakhs has been deposited in this Court and that amount may be remitted to the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Raipur, Chhatisgarh to be kept in a interest bearing account so that it can enure for the benefit of such of the parties as may be required.

A grievance is sought to be made by learned counsel for the State that the petitioner did not cooperate with the investigation as on the 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 he was directed to appear on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 but he did not so appear. Thereafter no further notice was sent to him. We may only say that this manner of investigation where the notice is issued to appear on the next day and thereafter there is silence does not give much credit to the police. We say no more.

The petitioner will now appear before the I.O. on a 48 hours notice being sent to him and will continue to cooperate with the investigation as and when required.

The petitioner shall remain on bail in view of the aforesaid condition.

The Special Leave Petition accordingly stands disposed of.
