On 11.02.2019, following order was passed by this Court:

"Issue notice, returnable in six weeks, confined to the question of quantum of sentence to be imposed for the offences for which the petitioner stands convicted.

Dasti in addition, is permitted.

List on 29.03.2019."

The respondent has thereafter entered appearance.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.ANS Nadkarni, learned Additional Solicitor General for the respondent.

Considering the facts and circumstances on record, while maintaining the order of conviction which was passed against the appellant, we reduce the sentence to one year imprisonment on both counts i.e. under Section 7 and Section 13(2) read with 13(2)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. Both the sentences shall run concurrently. We have not not modified the order of sentence of fine or any default sentence attached to the sentence of the fine. All those sentences are retained except the modification as mentioned above.

The appeal stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
