ORDER

1. None appears for the petitioner. We have heard the learned counsel for the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that during the pendency of the present transfer petition, a petition under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed by the petitioner in the Family Court at Malda, West Bengal and the stage of first motion in the said proceedings is over.

3. In view of the aforesaid development, the divorce proceedings in respect of which transfer has been sought by the petitioner - wife has become virtually infructuous. In fact, the learned counsel for the respondent submits that the same will be withdrawn by the respondent - husband. In

such a situation, we do not find any live issue for adjudication in the present transfer petition and the same is consequently closed as infructuous.
