O R D E R

In the peculiar facts of this case, we are not inclined to exercise our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. The special leave petitions are dismissed.

We find that the Labour Court is in seisin of the matter. We direct the Labour Court to pass an award in accordance with law, positively within three months from today.

We make it clear that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and the dispute shall be adjudicated on its own merits without being influenced by any of the observations

contained in the order passed by the High Court and the interim order passed by the Labour Court.
