O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the petitioner(wife) under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of DMC/617/2019 titled as "Neeraj Kumar Versus Geetanjali pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Haryana to the Family Court, East Delhi, Karkardooma Courts, New Delhi.

Notice was duly served on the sole respondent (husband). He did not enter his appearance or file his reply to this transfer petition.

Heard Mr. Mritunjay Kumar Sinha, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner is residing at Delhi and has filed a Maintenance case in Delhi. Therefore, the Restitution petition filed by the respondent should be transferred from the Family Court, Rewari, Haryana to a court of

competent jurisdiction at Delhi where the respondent has to appear in the Maintenance proceeding.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to allow the transfer petition. Accordingly, the DMC/617/2019 titled as "Neeraj Kumar Versus Geetanjali pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Haryana is transferred to the Family Court, East Delhi, Karkardooma Courts, New Delhi.

Let the records of the case be transferred to the concerned court without delay.

The Transfer Petition is, accordingly, allowed.
