O R D E R

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned counsel appearing for the sole respondent, who is on caveat, and carefully perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court dismissing the appeal of the petitioner.
