ORDER

The appellant has assailed the order dated 04.10.2016 passed by the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan in Criminal Appeal No. 363 of 2006, confirming the conviction and sentence dated 12.04.2006 passed by the Trial Court in Sessions Case No. 34/33 of 2006, by which he was directed to undergo sentence for a period of seven years and to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- on proving the charge of Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

After having heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and on perusal of the testimony of the prosecutrix, cross examination, statement of the doctor and the findings as recorded by the Trial Court, confirmed in appeal by the High Court, we are not inclined to interfere and to entertain this

appeal. Accordingly, the criminal appeal stands dismissed.

As the appellant is on bail; however, in consequence to dismissal of this appeal he shall surrender within two months from today, otherwise the Trial Court shall take him into custody through concerned police station and send him for jail to serve out the remaining part of the sentence.
