Nobody appears even on the second call.

Delay in filing and refiling the special leave
petition is condoned.

Having gone through the impugned judgment, we find
that an earlier PIL had been rejected on the ground that it
was belated and that respondent No. 5 had already been
promoted as Professor. The special leave petition against
the said order was dismissed as withdrawn on 12.10.2018. A
second PIL by a different person on substantially the same
cause of action, filed long after the first PIL was filed,
should suffer the same result. The High court has
therefore, correctly dismissed this PIL.

The special leave petition is, therefore, dismissed on
merits.
