O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. These are applications seeking recall of the order passed by this Court dated 13.9.2019 dismissing the SLP (C) Nos.24656-24657/2017. The order whose recall is prayed for reads thus:-

"Delay condoned.

On 13.04.2018, a statement was made before this Court that the petitioners have informed the learned counsel that the petitioners have been paying the licence fee since 1965. We had directed that an affidavit in this regard be filed and receipts be placed on record. Despite various opportunities being granted, no such affidavit has been filed nor receipts have been placed on record.

We are, therefore, not inclined to continue with the petitions any further. The special leave petitions are, therefore, dismissed. Stay order is vacated.
