Though we have dismissed the special leave petitions of the allottees which are filed against the order of the Division Bench denying them interest on the amount refunded after recording a categorical finding that the Government was not at fault, at the same time, we find that the counsel for the Government had conceded insofar as the payment of interest in this case is concerned.
