Learned counsel for the parties point out that mediation process did not bring about any fruitful result.

Learned counsel for the petitioner attempted to argue that certain findings as recorded in this

matter are not correct on facts. We do not propose to go into the factual aspect of the matter for the simple reason that ultimately the petitioner has been directed to make payment of amount of maintenance to the tune of Rs.18,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Thousand) per month for the purpose of his wife and two daughters.
