Leave granted.

The High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur Bench, Jaipur vide its impugned judgment and order dated 19.07.2016 in S.B.C.M.A. No. 1477 of 2013 has enhanced the total compensation from Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs) as awarded by the MACT, Jaipur, to Rs.10,56,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs and fifty six thousand).

We have heard the learned counsel for the parties. It is clear from the impugned judgment that the High court has granted meagre amount towards future medical expenses and also attendant charges.

Taking overall view of the matter, we are of the view that it is just and proper to award an additional sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) to the appellant-claimant.

The National Insurance Company is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) with interest @ 7% p.a. from the date of claim petition till the realisation of amount, with the MACT, Jaipur within a period of eight weeks from today, to be disbursed to the claimants.

Consequently, the appeal is disposed of.
