We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without expressing any opinion on merits, we direct that proceedings in Petition For Dissolution of Marriage NO.594 of 2014 AND in Case NO.426 of 2014 titled "Sahab Lal @ Manoj V. Smt. Nisha Devi" on the file of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jounpur, Uttar Pradesh, and the Family Court, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, respectively, shall stand transferred to the Principal Judge, Family Court, Mumbai, Maharashtra, for hearing and disposal in accordance with law.
