O R D E R

Heard Mr. Navin Prakash, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Avanish Rathi, learned counsel for the respondent-State.

It is submitted by Mr. Prakash, learned counsel for the petitioner that in a similar matter i.e. S.L.P.(Crl.) No.7740 of 2016 [*Vinod Kumar Sahu vs. State of Chhattisgarh*], the accused has been admitted to bail. The order passed in

the said case reads as follow:-

"For the grounds stated in the special leave petition and having regard to the fact that the petitioner is detained in jail custody for one year and three months, he is directed to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:-

(1) The petitioner shall furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousands only) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

(2) The petitioner shall get his presence marked before the concerned officer-in-charge/S.H.O. of the Police Station once in a month;

(3) The petitioner would produce his latest and full residential address in the concerned Trial Court/Police Station while obtaining bail and he shall not change his address without the prior permission of the Court.

(4) If the petitioner is holding a passport, he shall deposit the same in the concerned trial Court and if not, he should produce affidavit in that regard.

(5) The petitioner is directed to cooperate with the investigation of the case.

In the event of necessity of any further condition(s), depending on the attendant facts and circumstances, it would be open for the concerned trial Court to prescribe the same.

In case of any breach of the conditions, this Court, on being informed thereof, would, if inclined, initiate *suo motu* steps for cancellation of the bail, which is hereby granted."

The prayer for bail in the present special leave petition is allowed on similar terms and conditions.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed
of.
