O R D E R

Exemption from filing O.T. is allowed.

Office report dated 06.05.2017 indicates that service of show cause notice is complete on the repondent-State of Rajasthan but no one has entered appearance on its behalf.

We have heard Mr. Amit A. Pai, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

For the grounds stated in the Special Leave Petition, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The petitioner shall furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousands only) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
- 2) The petitioner shall get his presence marked before the concerned officer-in-charge/S.H.O. of the Police Station once in a month;
- 3) The petitioner would produce his latest and full residential address in the concerned Trial Court/Police Station while obtaining bail and he shall not change his address without the prior permission of the Court.
- 4) If the petitioner is holding a passport, he shall deposit the same in the concerned trial Court and if not, he should produce affidavit in that regard.
- 5) The petitioner is directed to cooperate with the investigation of the case.

In the event of necessity of any further condition(s), depending on the attendant facts and circumstances, it would be open for the concerned trial Court to prescribe the same.

In case of any breach of the conditions, the respondent can approach this Court for cancellation of the bail, which is hereby granted.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the afore-stated terms.
