The suit filed by respondent No.1 against respondent No.3 was decreed and respondent No.3 was directed to pay sum of Rs.1.02 crores with interest. In execution, the property of respondent No.3 was sold. Later, three shareholders of respondent No.3 - judgment debtor raised objections which were rejected by the Executing Court and the High Court. The view so taken by the Courts below was affirmed while dismissing Special Leave Petition.

We have gone through the review petition and do not find any error apparent on record to justify interference in review jurisdiction.
