Permission to file SLP is granted.

The Writ Petition¹ which has been instituted by the petitioners is admittedly pending before the High Court of Punjab and Haryana. In this view of the matter, and particularly having regard to the previous orders passed by this Court on 27 November 2019 and 9 December 2019 in Petition for Special Leave to Appeal² and 28158/2019, we
