O R D E R

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 342/2019, dated 18.08.2019, registered at Police Station Karol Bagh, District Central, Delhi, against the petitioner at the behest of the complainant/respondent no.2.

The complainant has filed her own affidavit and she is present before the Court today and submits that due to some misunderstanding she filed a complaint against the present

petitioner, on which an FIR has been registered. It has been stated in her affidavit that later they have solemnized their marriage and got it registered on 16.10.2019 and since then both of them are happily living together and the petitioner at present is Sub-Inspector in U.P. Police.
