O R D E R

We do not find any ground to interfere in the order of remand passed by the High Court. The special leave petition is dismissed.

However, we make it clear that the observations made by the High Court in the impugned judgment shall not influence the Medical Council of India to decide the matter on merits.

All questions are kept open.

Having regard to the material on record, we deem it

appropriate to stay the decision of the Delhi Medical Council for derecognition of the registration of the petitioner for a period of three months.

It is open for the Medical Council of India to take decision with regard to the guilt of the petitioner after hearing the petitioner within three months.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
