O R D E R

The Court is convened through video conferencing.

We have heard Mr. Ashok Kr. Panda, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners along with Mr. Satyabrata Panda, learned Advocate-on-record.

As per order dated 14.02.2020, this Court has directed learned counsel for the petitioners to file certified copy of the deposition of PW-6 which has been filed by learned counsel.
