This petition is filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of **Suit No. 629 of 2019** titled as “**Dr. Mohammed Asad Vs. Shamsiya Naaz**” from the Family Court at Mau, Uttar Pradesh to the Family Court, Urban District, Bangalore, Karnataka.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, we deem it fit and proper to allow this transfer petition. Accordingly, **Suit No. 629 of 2019** titled as “**Dr. Mohammed Asad Vs.
