O R D E R

On the last occasion, learned counsel for the respondent made a submission that the respondent shall be withdrawing the suit (Civil Suit No.720 of 2018) itself regarding which the present transfer petition has been filed.

2. Today, learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has clear instructions to the effect that the respondent (plaintiff) is not interested in prosecuting the said civil suit seeking perpetual injunction and seeks to withdraw the same.

3. Learned counsel points out that as per his instructions, further hearing having not reached in the Trial Court, the prayer for withdrawal could not be made but the next date fixed in the Trial Court is 15.12.2022.

4. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly when the respondent does not

intend to prosecute the suit and is seeking permission to withdraw and on the other hand, the present petitioner (defendant) is seeking its transfer, in our view, the interest of justice shall be served by permitting the respondent (plaintiff) to withdraw and to conclude the proceedings in the civil suit in the present petition itself.

5. Accordingly, the respondent (plaintiff) is permitted to withdraw and the said civil suit bearing No.720/2018 pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi, is dismissed as withdrawn.

6. In view of the above, this transfer petition is rendered redundant and stands disposed of as such.

7. All pending applications stand disposed of.
