UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The petitioners were convicted for the charges under Sections 323/34, 504 and 325/34 of the Indian Penal Code and directed to undergo the sentence of three months rigorous imprisonment with fine of Rs. 200/- u/s 323/34, three months rigorous imprisonment with fine of Rs.200/- u/s 504 and one year rigorous imprisonment with fine of Rs. 400/- u/s 325/34 IPC . The revision filed against the said

order was dismissed by the High Court and aggrieved, petitioners have filed this Special Leave Petition.

Upon issuance of notice, an application [I.A.No. 5831 of 2020] seeking permission to compound the offence invoking the powers of compounding under Section 320 of Cr.P.C. has been filed. It is to be noted that the injured had died and the legal heirs of the deceased have filed this application along with their affidavits to contend that they have settled the disputes and want to maintain peace and harmony.

Considering the nature of offence and the prayer as made for compounding, we grant permission and accordingly, the Judgment of conviction against the petitioners is set aside in view of the settlement arrived between the parties.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.
