O R D E R

We have heard Mr. Ajit Kumar Thakur, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

The petitioner is before this Court assailing Order dated 01.11.2019 passed by the Division Bench of the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan in D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No.1564 of 2019. While assailing the order passed by the High Court, learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the ground 'D' raised in the writ petition, page 55 of the SLP papers, contending that though the advertisement provides 15 bonus marks, the Authorities have

provided only 15% of the marks which has affected the petitioner. Though such contention is urged we find that the High Court has not adverted to this aspect and disposed of the writ appeal, D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No.1564 of 2019, by noting only one of the contentions.

If that be so, it is open for the petitioner to urge the said contention by filing a review petition before the High Court.

With the said liberty, the special leave petition stand disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
