O R D E R

1. It is a case of the claimants arising out of the compensation awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Rohtak (For short 'Tribunal') in case No. 19 of 2002. The Tribunal has awarded the compensation to the petitioners/claimants to the tune of Rs.42,66,672/- which has been enhanced by the High court to Rs. 1,00,79,136/- alongwith interest @ 7.5% per annum.

2. We see absolutely no reason to interfere with the impugned order in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

3. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
