O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 4 states that pursuant to the undertaking given to this Court, the possession of the entire property has been handed over to the contempt petitioner.

2. It is submitted that insofar as the room, which is being claimed by the petitioner, is a commercial property and the same is owned by respondent Nos. 1 to 4 after purchasing it through a registered sale deed.

3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 5 to 8 states that though first floor was not part of the claim in the suit still in pursuance of the order passed by the this Court, the possession thereof has been handed over to the contempt petitioner.

4. We, therefore, find that there is no

necessity to continue with the contempt proceedings.

5. In the event, if the petitioner has any claim with regard to the separate room, which according to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 is an independent commercial property owned by them, the petitioner would be at liberty to take such steps, as may be permissible in law.

6. The contempt petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of.
