Leave granted.

The High Court of Punjab and Haryanat at Chandigarh vide its judgment dated 25.9.2019 passed in CrI. Revision No. 548 of 2009 partly allowed the revision Petition and reduced the sentence as awarded under Section 304A IPC by the trial court and confirmed by the first appellate court, from rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year to rigorous imprisonment for a period six months.

Having heard learned counsel for the appellant and keeping in view the fact that the appellant is 76 years of age and other peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the sentence of rigorous imprisonment as imposed on the appellant is hereby reduced to four months. However, there

would be no modification in the fine.

With the abovesaid modification in the High Court Order, the appeal is disposed of.

The bail bond of the appellant is cancelled and he is directed to surrender before the authorities concerned within a period of four weeks from today to serve the remaining sentence.
