O R D E R

The Writ Petition filed by the petitioner was taken up along with Writ Petition No.11121 of 2019. The High Court of Judicature at Bombay refused to grant interim relief claimed by the petitioner as well as the petitioner in Writ Petition No.11121 of 2019 on the basis of a discussion of the case in Writ

Petition No.11121 of 2019, Mr. Vinay Navare, learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that apart from the relief of Bank Guarantee, the interim relief sought by the petitioner also pertains to the stay of the order dated 24.10.2019 by which Industrial Entrepreneur Memorandum (IEM) has been cancelled. There is no discussion by the High Court about the facts in the Writ Petition filed by the petitioner and the interim relief claimed therein.

We are not inclined to interfere with the order of the High Court. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed. Pending application, if any stand disposed of.

However, we grant relief to the petitioner to approach the High Court by filing an application for modification of the impugned order. The High Court may decide the application filed by the petitioner at the earliest and not later than one month from today, as the Bank Guarantee will expire on 20.01.2020.
