UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

We are appalled to notice the untenable plea taken by the applicant for not giving effect to the order dated 04.11.2019 passed in SLP(C) D. No. 41315 of 2017 and SLP(C) D. No. 41318 of 2017 in its letter and spirit. The stand taken by the applicant, to say the least, is preposterous and an attempt to circumvent the directions issued by this Court on 04.11.2019 and further clarified vide order dated 05.02.2020 passed in the misc. applications under consideration. No further elaboration thereof is required.

We direct the authorities to comply with the directions contained in the aforementioned orders without any exception within two weeks from today. No further indulgence will be shown to the concerned authorities who are obliged to comply with the same. Failure to comply would result in having committed aggravated contempt of the court, which will be viewed sternly.

We place on record our disapproval about the tenor of the affidavit filed in response to order dated 05.02.2020. We find that the affiant has not disclosed the specific fact noted in the order dated 05.02.2020, which he was expected to disclose.

In the peculiar facts of the present case, the misc. applications are rejected with the aforesaid directions.
