Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner is seeking transfer of the Case No. CC/57184/2022, titled "M/s BOSCH Limited vs. Satnam Singh" filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 from the court of Additional Judge Court of Small Causes at Bangalore to any other court of competent jurisdiction at Delhi.

The sole submission of the counsel for the petitioner is that Bangalore Court has no jurisdiction in the matter.

If that be so, it is open to the petitioner to raise such an objection before the Magistrate concerned and in case any such objection is raised regarding jurisdiction, it is expected that the Magistrate will consider and decide the same in accordance with law.

Otherwise, no case for entertaining the transfer petition is made out.

Accordingly, the transfer petition is dismissed.
