Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than one year and the chargesheet has already been filed, we think it is a fit case to grant bail to the petitioner herein.

The petitioner is, accordingly, directed to be enlarged on bail on such terms and conditions to be imposed by the trial court.

We direct the petitioner not to indulge in any unlawful act and not to influence the witnesses.

We also direct the trial court to expedite the trial and dispose of the matter, pending adjudication before it, expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
