O R D E R

The petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 25 of CPC seeking transfer of H.M.A No. 166 of 2019 titled 'Sh. Mukul Jain vs. Smt. Anjali Jain' pending before Principal Judge, Family Court, Morena, Madhya Pradesh to the Court of Principal Judge, Family court, Karkardooma Court, Shahdara, Delhi.

Office Report indicates that service of notice on the sole respondent is complete but no one has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent, and no counter affidavit has been filed to oppose the prayer made by the petitioner. Under the circumstances, it is presumed that the respondent is not interested in contesting the present petition.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and perused the averments made in the instant petition. Having considered the facts and circumstance of the case
