The petitioner is claiming to be released by granting the benefit of remission on the ground that the petitioner has actually undergone more than 15 years of sentence/imprisonment. Let the petitioner move before an appropriate authority of the State seeking the benefit of remission including the remedy which may be available under the Jail Manual/Government Policy and if such an application is made within a period of four weeks, the same be considered in accordance with law and on its own merits and in view of the observations and directions issued by this Court in the recent judgment dated 06.09.2022 passed in Writ Petition (Crl.) No.336 of 2019 - Rashidul Jafar @ Chota v. State of Uttar Pradesh & Anr. Such a decision be taken at the earliest but not later than three months from the date of receipt of such an application.

Till an appropriate decision is taken, the petitioner is directed to be continued on bail, granted pursuant to the earlier Order passed by this Court.
