The Court is convened through video conferencing.

We have heard Mr. Aditya Kumar Choudhary, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

This special leave petition arises out of Order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Madras in C.R.P. (NPD) No.1624 of 2019 dated 06.08.2019 in and by which the High Court has condoned the delay of 2372 days in filing the application for setting aside the order of dismissal of the suit and for restoration of the suit on payment of cost of Rs.50,000/-.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.
