ORDER

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

(2) In this petition, the petitioner-wife has sought for transfer of the matrimonial case bearing M.P. No.1380 of 2019 titled "Amandeep Singh Sood v. Avneet Kaur" pending before the Court of the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pune, Maharashtra to the Family Court, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.

(3) On the request of learned counsel for the parties, on 25th January, 2022, the matter was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement of the dispute between the parties. In the mediation, the matter was amicably settled between the parties and the Mediation Centre has sent a Settlement Deed/Agreement dated 28th April, 2022 duly signed by both the parties and their respective learned advocates containing the terms and conditions governing the settlement. In terms of the

Settlement Agreement, the respondent-husband has agreed to pay a total sum of Rs.18,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Lakhs only) to the petitioner-wife as full and final settlement towards her maintenance. As per the Settlement Agreement, both the parties have agreed to withdraw the cases filed by them against each other.

(4) Both the parties now pray for invoking our jurisdiction under Article 142 of the Constitution of India and seek dissolution of their marriage by granting a decree of divorce by mutual consent.

(5) Having regard to the amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, the marriage between the petitioner-Avneet Kaur (wife) and the respondent-Amandeep Singh Sood (husband) stands dissolved by way of decree of divorce by mutual consent. The Settlement Agreement dated 28th April, 2022 shall form part of this order.

(6) The respondent-husband has handed over a demand draft No.000083 dated 07.10.2022 of HDFC Bank for a sum of Rs.18,00,000/- to the learned counsel of the petitioner-wife in the Court.

(7) In view of above, matrimonial case bearing M.P. No.1380 of 2019 titled "Amandeep Singh Sood v. Avneet Kaur" pending before the Court of the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pune, Maharashtra is dismissed as withdrawn.

(8) All other cases filed by the parties against each other, which are referred to in the Settlement Agreement, stand quashed.

(9) I.A. No.133429 of 2022 is allowed and the Transfer Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

(10) The parties shall abide by the terms and conditions as contained in the Settlement Agreement dated 28th April, 2022 without fail.

(11) Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
