O R D E R

The criminal petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by the petitioner(s) for quashing of the complaint and the summoning order thereof was dismissed by the High Court with liberty to the petitioner(s) to surrender within thirty days, during which period, no coercive steps be taken against them and they were set at

liberty to apply for bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that similar complaints have been filed against them and that the local bar is against them.
