O R D E R

The present petition is challenging the impugned judgment and order dated 01-11-2018 passed by the High Court Of Judicature At Madras in Criminal Original Petition being CRLOP No.6088/2018 by which the High Court has cancelled the anticipatory bail granted in

favour of the petitioner nos.2 to 5 herein who are parents-in-law and other relatives.

It is reported that the charge-sheet is already filed and the trial is going on and it is at the stage of listing of appearance of the accused.

In view of the above, when the charge-sheet has already been filed, the custodial interrogation is not required. However, it is reported that the petitioners-accused are not remaining present in the Court. We make the order dated 01.03.2019 absolute and order that in case of arrest of petitioner nos.2 to 5, they be released on bail on the terms and conditions which may be determined by the learned trial court.

The petitioners are also directed to appear and remain present before the concerned trial court on every date of hearing of the trial unless they are specifically exempted by the concerned court.

With this, the present special leave petition stands disposed of.
