O R D E R

We decline to interfere in this special leave petition as it is directed against a just order passed by the High Court rejecting prayer for setting aside the orders of Sessions Court cancelling its earlier order granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the dismissal of the special leave petition will not come in the way of the petitioner to pursue regular bail application, which he may file

within four weeks from today after surrendering before the concerned Court. Till then no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

If 48 hours' advance notice is given to the public prosecutor before moving the proposed bail application, the concerned Court may decide the bail application expeditiously on its own merits in accordance with law without being influenced by the impugned order passed by the Sessions Court/High Court, as the case may be.

In view of the above, pending applications shall stand disposed of.
