

Court. The applicant shall abide by the conditions as enumerated under Section 437(3) of the Cr.P.C. and in the event of breach of condition of bail, the trial Court will be competent to take coercive action against the applicant. It is further directed that the amount so deposited shall be kept in the form of FDR for a period of 3 years before the trial Court and shall be subject to the final outcome of the trial.

This M.Cr.C. stands allowed and disposed of. C.C. as per rules"

Subsequently, application of modification of the conditions was filed by the petitioner submitting *inter alia* that he was unable to deposit the sum of Rs.30 lakhs and because of his inability, the petitioner was not being released on bail. Said application having been rejected by the High Court, the present special leave petition has been filed.

Since the facility of bail was granted by the High Court, subject to the condition that the amount of Rs.30 lakhs be deposited by the petitioner, the merits of the matter were not gone into by the High Court in detail. In the circumstances, we see no reason to interfere.

We however grant liberty to the petitioner to move the concerned Court afresh and seek appropriate relief of facility of bail on merits of the matter.

The special leave petition is accordingly disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
