We have heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order. The special leave petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.

However, the petitioner is directed to pay to the respondent-wife the balance amount of Rs.1,99,000/- (Rupees one lakhs ninety nine thousand) in two equal instalments. The first instalment of Rs.99,500/- (Rupees ninety nine thousand five hundred) is payable within four weeks from today and the next instalment of Rs.

99,500/- ((Rupees ninety nine thousand five hundred) is payable within four weeks thereafter.

On failure to pay any one of the instalments, the respondent-wife is at liberty to execute the order in accordance with law.
