We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The documents alleged by the petitioner to confer ownership on him, in FSL examination, have been found to have discrepancy of signature. In view of this material, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail. We, however, make it clear that the observations made in para 10 of the impugned order would only be *prima facie* in nature.

We have taken note of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that he has cooperated and is willing to cooperate

with the investigation and thus, it will depend on the investigation agency whether they feel any custodial interrogation is required or not.

At request of learned counsel for the petitioner, we grant two weeks' time to surrender and apply for regular bail and on such application being filed, the same will be considered as expeditiously as possible.

The Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
