We have heard Ms. Deepa M. Kulkarni, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Vinay Navare, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 3 -caveat.

This special leave petition arises out of the interim order of the High Court in and by which the High Court stayed the order of the Tribunal dated 26.06.2017.

Mr. Vinay Navare, learned senior counsel submitted that the elections were held and some of the respondents had contested the elections.

Having regard to the above submissions and also of the fact that the interim order is dated 06.06.2018, we are not inclined to entertain the special leave petition.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of by requesting the High Court to take up the Writ Petition No. 9573 of 2017 at an early date and dispose of the same preferably within four months.

It is made clear that the observations of the High Court in the impugned judgment shall be construed only for the purpose of the interim order.
