UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Mr. Anand Sanjay Nuli, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent, upon instructions, states that the respondent is ready and willing to pay the

entire amount awarded by the Trial Court, i.e. total amount of Rs.7,60,000/- (Seven Lakhs Sixty Thousand). However, he submits that a reasonable time of six months may be allowed.

On the other hand, Mr. Shekhar G. Devasa, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) submits that three months' time may be granted.

Considering the nature of request made, we direct the respondent to pay initially an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs) within three months and thereafter the balance amount of Rs.4,60,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Sixty Thousand) be paid in the next three months.

The amount of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand) said to be deposited with the Trial Court, to be adjusted while making the payment of second instalment. In effect, the second instalment would be of Rs.3,10,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Ten Thousand).

The amount of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand) lying in deposit with the Trial Court, may be paid to the petitioner(s) along with accrued interest, if any, within two weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

In the event of any default by the respondent in

making the aforesaid payments, there would be an interest component of 12% per annum from today on the defaulted amount.

The Special Leave Petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.

Pending application(s) shall also stand disposed of.
